Oak Grove 2007 Reserve Viognier (California); \$8. Kudos to Oak Grove for making such a nice wine at this everyday price. Drinks crisp in acidity and dry, with an ultraclean, spicy finish. Flavorwise, you'll find grilled nectarines and pineapples, with a touch of vanilla. This is a tremendous value.

Oak Grove 2007 Reserve Pinot Grigio (California); \$8. Here's a Pinot Grigio that fulfills the variety's basic responsibilities of dryness, crispness and a clean mouthfeel. It's a drily brisk, racy wine, with suggestions of ripe pink grapefruit, lemongrass and honeysuckle.
